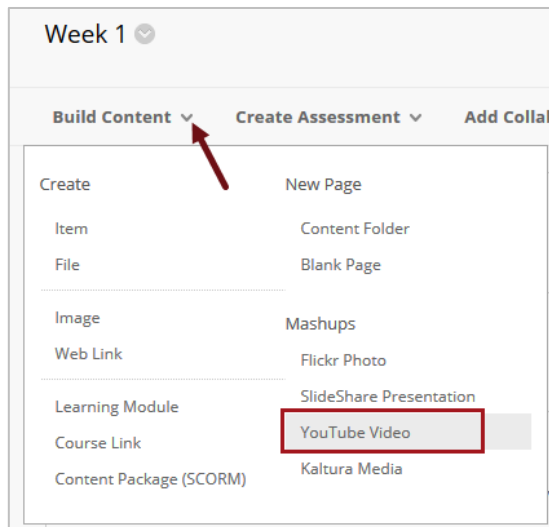


EMBED YOUTUBE VIDEO

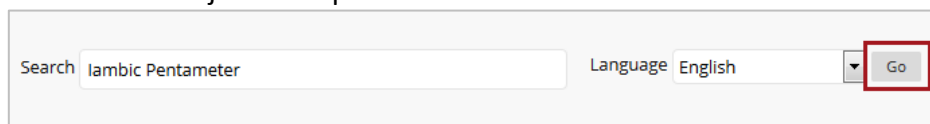
Embedding is a way to add a YouTube video to your course so it can be viewed by students without having to leave the ulearn site. This will prevent students from accidentally closing ulearn and it allows for easy movement between content within ulearn.

Instructions

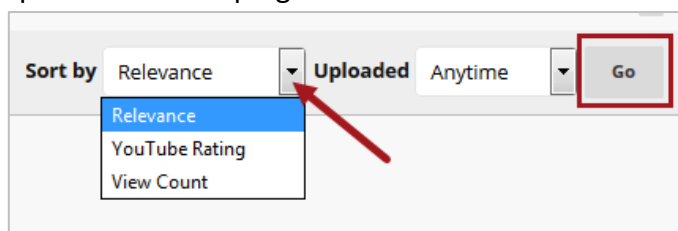
1. Within a content area, click **Build Content**. Under **Mashups**, choose **YouTube Video**.



2. Search for a subject or a specific title. Click **Go**.

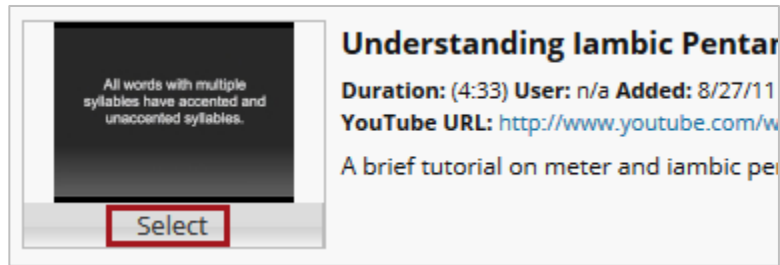


3. You can manage how results display by changing the **Sort by** and **Uploaded** options on the top right.

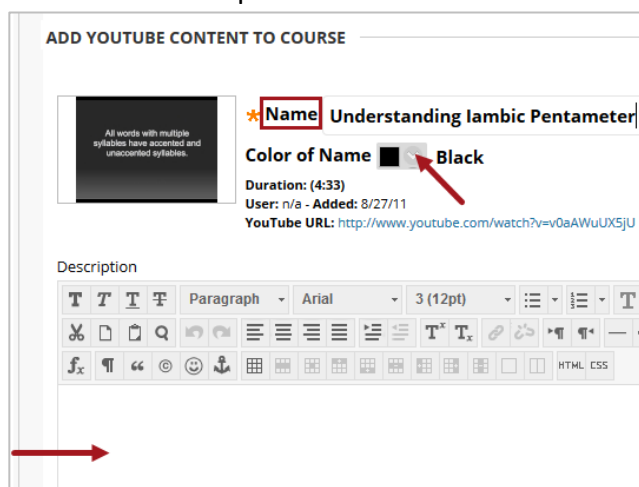


4. Click on **Preview** to watch the video or **Select** to add the video to your course.

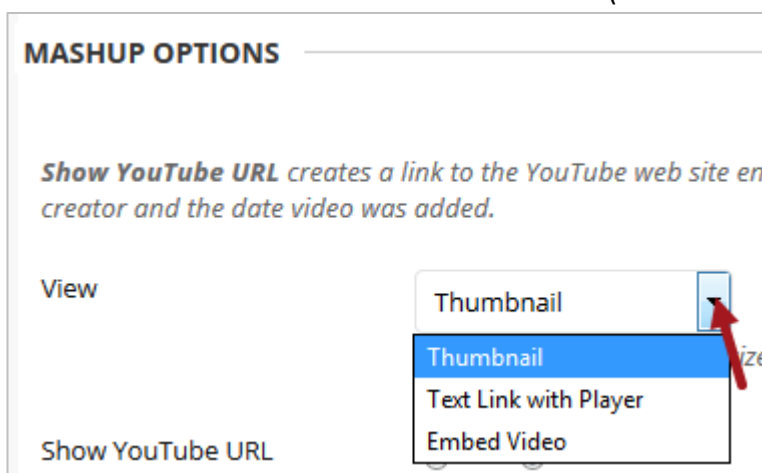
EMBED YOUTUBE VIDEO



- The name populates with the title of the YouTube Video. You can change the title. Add a description of the video in the text box.



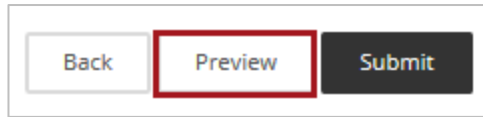
- Choose Mashup options. Under **View**, select **Embed Video**. You can choose whether to show information about the video (URL and YouTube information).



- Set the availability options.
