EXCLUDING TEMPLATES IN TURNITIN




The new version of Turnitin (2022) allows you to exclude assignment templates from similarity reports. This means Turnitin ignores the template's language and just scans students' written submission content, thus avoiding erroneous plagiarism flags. Please follow the instructions below to use the template exclusion function.

Instructions

Option 1: Attach a template as a file

1. Create your assignment in the Turnitin interface. Instruct students to use the template for their submission, which you'll attach in the next step.



2. To upload an assignment template for exclusion, click "Optional Settings" to open the menu.




Before uploading your template, please check the requirements, as Turnitin only allows certain file types and has a minimum word percentage for text.






3. When ready, click **Upload Template** and select your file.



4. Remember to click **Submit** before you leave the page. **Note**: saving settings for future use will not save the template for subsequent class assignments.



5. Now you can attach the template to the ulearn assignment. Leave the Turnitin interface and go to your assignment area in ulearn to attach the file.

Option 2: Make a custom template in the Turnitin interface:

1. You also have the option to create a custom template directly in the Turnitin interface.

Follow the same steps for the file-based option listed above, but, when you get to the template section, click **Create Custom Template**.



2. When the textbox appears, you can cut and paste content from another source or type directly into it. Keep in mind that the custom template has a minimum word count set to 20 words.



3. Click **Save Template** when ready, and, just like the file template, saving settings for future use will not save the template for subsequent class assignments.
