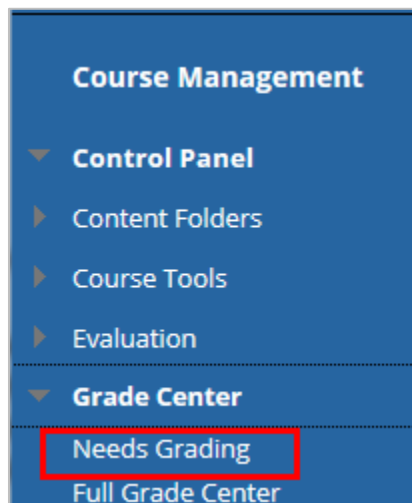


GRADE A TEST BY QUESTION

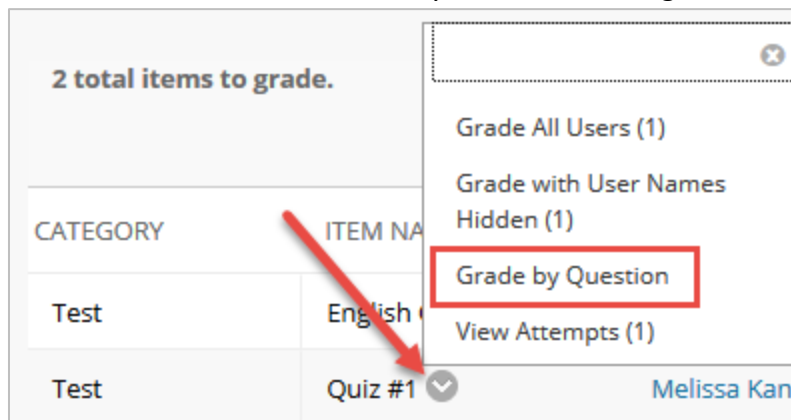
For any test, you can choose to grade all responses to a specific question at one time. This makes grading short answer and essay questions more efficient and consistent. Grading by question also lets you review automatically fill-in-the-blank questions that may require score adjustments. For any question, you have the option to grade anonymously, which means that you will not know which student gave each response while you are grading.

Instructions

1. In the Course Management menu, under Grade Center, select **Needs Grading**.




2. Click the down arrow of the test you would like to grade. Click **Grade by Question**.




