

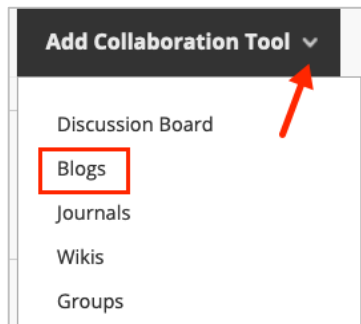
# CREATE A BLOG

A blog is a collaborative tool that allows students to post their personal reflections about the course or discuss and analyze course related topics. Instructors can create a blog and link to it in their ulearn course.

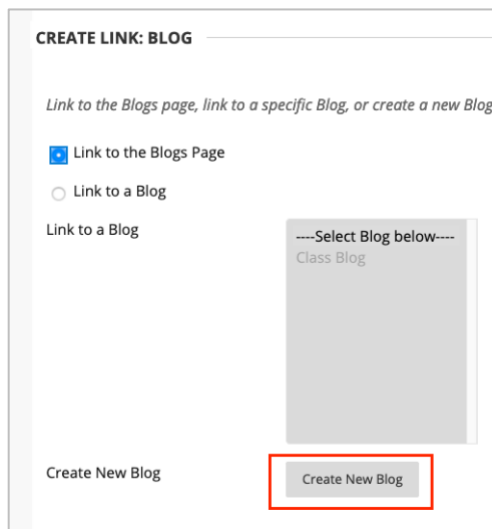
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## Instructions

1. From within a [content area](#), hover over **Add Collaboration Tool** and select **Blogs** from the menu.



2. Click on the **Create New Blog** button.



3. On the **Blog Information** screen, enter the blog **Name** and any **Instructions** into the textboxes provided.

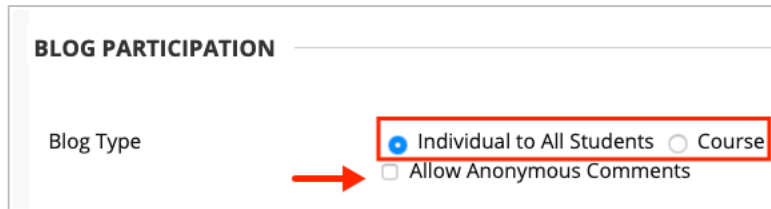
5. In the Blog Participation section, select the **Blog Type** preferred:

**Individual to All Students:** Students can add entries only to their blog. All other course members can view and add comments to it

**Course:** Instructors create a course blog and choose the topic. All course members can add blog entries and comment on blog entries.

**Uncheck** Allow Anonymous Comments in order to view student names associated with any comments.



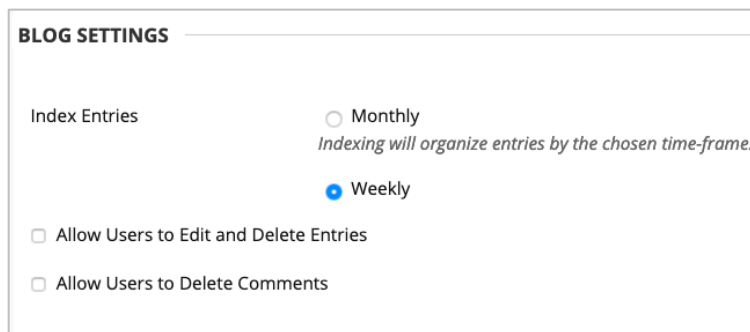

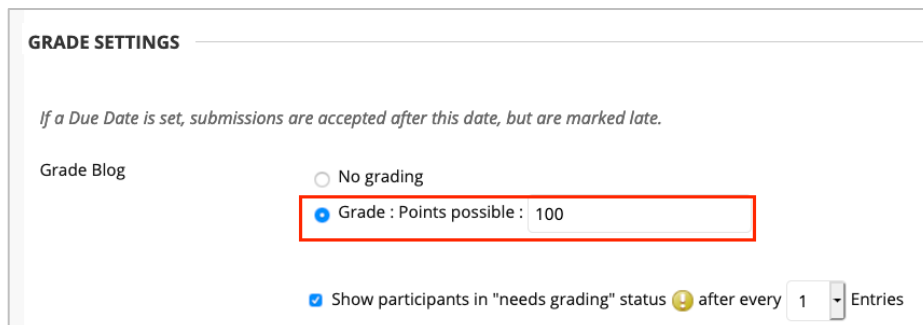

7. To enable blog grading, select **Grade** and enter the total **Points Possible**. This will create a column in the grade center. To **Show participants in "needs grading" status**, check box and select number of **Entries** from the drop down box.

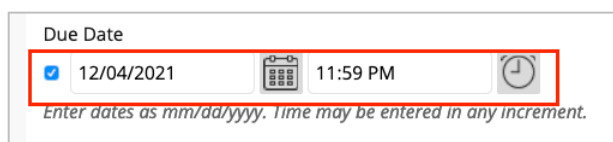

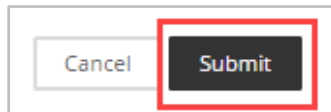

Associated Rubrics Add Rubric

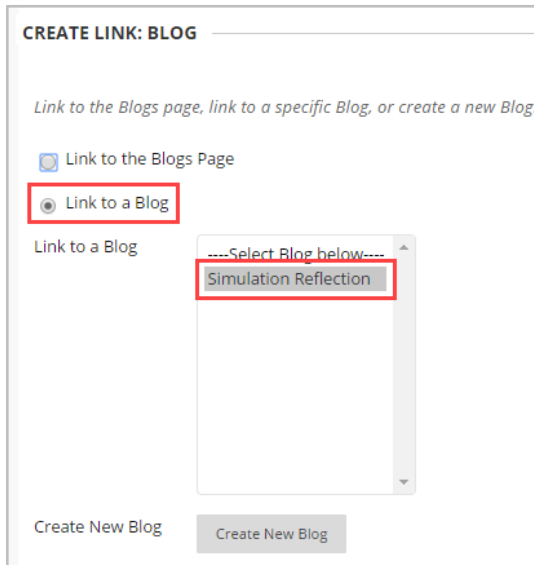

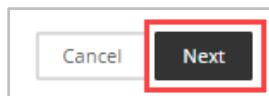
