Creating a Thread

1. Navigate to the discussion forum you want to start a thread in. Near the top of the discussion forum, click **Create Thread.**



 On the Create Thread page, enter a Subject and Message. If you want to attach a file, click Browse My Computer or Browse Course to find the appropriate file. Click Submit when finished or Save Draft if you not ready to post the thread.
