

The Post First Discussion setting requires students to create a thread prior to reading any other posts in the discussion forum. Use this feature if you want students to post their individual response to a discussion question before reading and responding to other posts. Consider explaining to students in the discussion prompt or syllabus that they need to post before they can see others' posts.

Instructions

1. Within a course <u>content area</u> (i.e., Week 1), click on **Discussion Board** under the **Add Collaboration Tool** tab.



2. Select Create New Forum button. Then select Next.

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3. Provide a name and enter a description for your forum.

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4. In the Forum Availability section, leave Available set to Yes. It is not advisable to enter any date restrictions here. You can enter them later in another step.

5. In the Forum Settings section under Viewing Threads/Replies, click the button next to Participants must create a thread to view other threads in this forum.



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6. In the Grade section, click **Grade Discussion Forum** and enter points possible. This will also create a grade center column for you to easily grade the discussion.



 Make sure Show participants in "needs grading" status is set to at least 1 post. Enter a due date. Add a <u>ulearn rubric</u> if you have one for the discussion. If you don't have a rubric, return to this area later to <u>associate a rubric</u>.
